Greetings to you from Upper Ganges Section. We would like to give sincere thanks to you for the consideration that you have shown to the Upper Ganges Section through various ways in the past by land purchasing, church plantation, and conversion meetings. By the grace of Almighty God we are expanding God's work through the provided means. We have a desire to work in the Hindu areas of Upper Ganges Section where the word of God is still needed to be spread. Due to the declination of various denominations in several district there are much chances to enter in these area and spread the truth. We are getting the information from the field that many villages are there without the conversion meetings. This is the best time to enter in hindu areas. We have selected some people who are ready to conversion work for the Adventist mission to spread the money. We believe that these workers will be the healthy tool for the conversion movement. There by we have selected 15 village for conversion.

Greeting to you from Upper Ganges Section. It was nice talking to you on Phone regarding 5 centres for Hinduism Ministry. We are always grateful and thankful to you the leadership of Division for the concern towards Evangelism, Land purchasing, Church Construction and Stipend for the Volunteers with the fund and the spiritual support for the cause of God. By the grace of God, we are expanding Evangelism work day by day and step by step. At the same time we would like to go forward into the unentered area of Upper Ganges Section. One such project we have in district **Bijnor** and its rural area. We have already established few centres in the past but could not enter into many villages and town due to the lack of fund and Adventist force.

Let me introduce Bijnor to you. This district is 110 Km from Hapur and 140 Km from New Delhi. This area has been totally neglected by Upper Ganges Section in the previous years. Year before we have constructed a church at Nazimabad which is 30 Km away from Bijnor. One GO Volunteer was assigned to evangelize in this area and within a year 260 people were baptized in the name of Jesus Christ and most of the people come from the Hindu background. This area is dominated by Hindus with a few Christians which come from the Methodist background. People are moving away from the Methodist church as they are not nourished spiritually by the Methodist Pastors. We have assigned one Volunteer in this area who himself came from Hindu background later he accepted the Adventist truth and due to his effort many people are joining the Adventist Church. We have selected 5 places around District Bijnor where we are willing to work. The names of the places are as follows:



**Sub: 50 Village Evangelism Program**

Respected Sir,

Enclosed please find the plan and the budget for the 50 village program in the territory of Upper Ganges Section. Thanking you very much for your concern towards the Upper Ganges Section and helping us with the funds and the spiritual support for the Evangelism and planting churches. By the grace of God we are expanding evangelism work day by day and step by step. At the same time we would like to go forward into the unentered area of **Farukkabad, Bareilly, Rampur, Bijnor and Badaun**. We have already established few centers in the past but could not enter into many villages due to the lack of the fund and Adventist force. In the past 100 years, these territories were dominated by the Methodist church and very recently by the Gramin Prachin Mandal. Now a days these organizations have been declining and the members are without the shepherded. In the last 20-30 years many have become backsliders. This is the right time to conduct the evangelistic meetings in these four districts. We are happy to inform you that in these areas some of the Adventist Youth are doing independent ministry. Therefore it is our request to you to provide us the stipend of atleast 10 pastors who are working in these areas. We are planning to conduct 50 village program in these districts. We have studied the territory of Upper Ganges Section and inquired from our Pastors, we have found that the 50 village Evangelism program can be conducted in our section.

1. In the year end committee of Northern India Union, I have presented the future evangelism program in Rampur and Bareilly area. Already we have conducted 10- village Evangelism program in Rampur in the month of November in 2003. So many villages have come in the light where the members of the Methodist Church are neglected and where nobody is visiting and giving Bible studies. The Methodist church is not taking much interest in rural areas. So as this plan has come, we can conduct 50 village program at Rampur and Bareilly rural areas. Here we will not have any social, political and religious problem from the

communities. We can get the fruits from these places if we get extra volunteers to serve in these areas after the Evangelism is conducted.

2. Another plan comes under Badaun and its rural areas. This area is also neglected by the Methodist Church. In this area we will not have any social, political and religious problems. In the year 2004 we had conducted two Evangelism programs in this area and we got good results.
3. The Third territory is Bijnor and its rural area. We are getting good reports from the volunteer of Bijnor as there are positive chances to have a good number of members in this area. This is the Roman Catholic dominated area. We need to work hard among these people, but the fruit will be good in this area also.
4. The fourth territory is Farukkabad area. This area is dominated by the Methodist Church and Gramin Prachin Mandal. Both the organizations are not looking after the members and they are scattering in search of spiritual messages. Last month I have spent 4 days along with volunteers of the area where we conducted the effort meeting and survey the field. We have found that there is a need to conduct and Evangelistic meeting and distribution of the Biblical Literature and Adventist material. By the grace of God 200 people were baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.

We would appreciate it very much if we are provided opportunity, we will be able to accomplish much in the field not by visiting only but by teaching them to become the faithful steward of God. We are hoping that if we conduct 50 village program nearly 7 to 10,000 people will be able to listen the Adventist message. We need to distribute them Bible, Literature, Song book and Adventist Literature. Following these procedure we will be able to baptize more than 3000 people during these evangelistic meeting. We can achieve our goal for which we are chosen. Please continue to pray for our work as we are working in the God's vineyard.



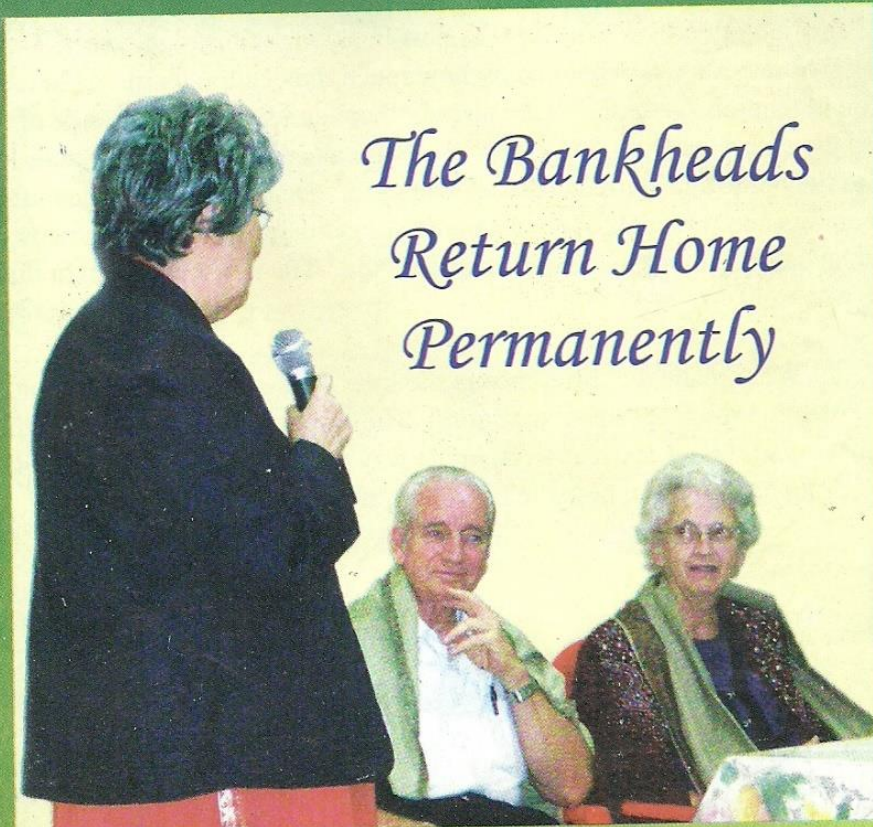

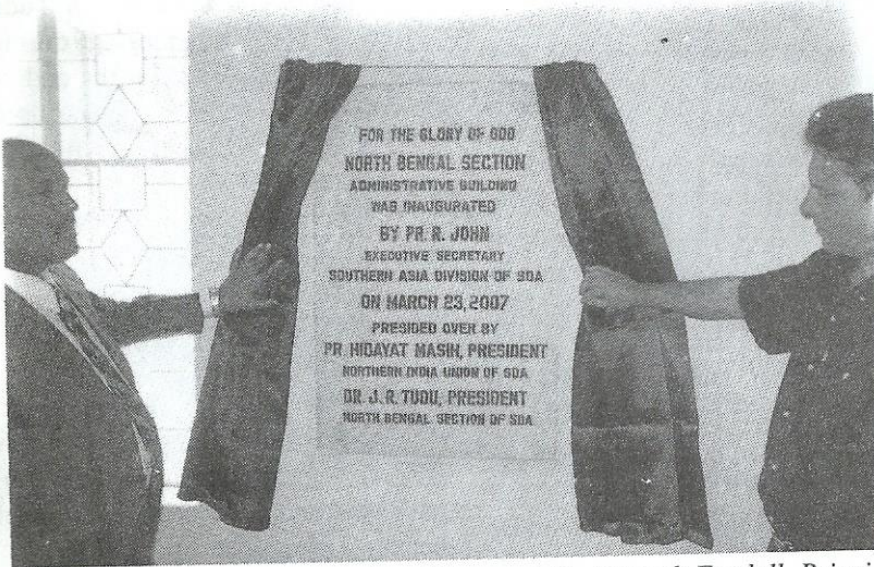

# North Bengal Section Housed in New Headquarters

The North Bengal Section is finally housed in its own headquarters' building. Initially this Section was called the North Frontier Region with headquarters in Siliguri (in a rented building) and then it shifted to Falakata where it has been functioning from a rented building for 10 years. Dr. J R Tudu, the youngest president in the history of the Section, worked towards the fulfilment of this dream. He and his late wife, Mrs. Rita Tudu, saw the urgent need, and struggled to somehow start the construction of the building with only Rs.1000.
